54 kids, cavities and fillings.

Every month kids from different backgrounds and 6 different communities come to receive help from our Dental Clinic. Many of them have never had any dental work done before. Last month we had a 5 year old with tooth decay in almost all of her teeth. She still had her baby teeth, but for us, it is a sign that worse can come if she didn't get treated soon. That day she got her teeth cleaned and also had two teeth extracted. We believe that even small actions can make a huge impact!

While the kids wait for their turn we also play games with them, and feed them some breakfast or lunch. 95% of the kids we receive, only get 1 to 2 meals a day.

VIRTUAL LEARNING CENTER

Vuelta de Jorco

Since May 18th, our virtual center started with 11 students. We travel 1 hour from Desamparados to Vuelta de Jorco every Tuesday.

The Pandemic came with damaging implications for the future of children. Schools were closed for several months making a huge impact but the closure of schools does not affect everyone equally. Those who live in poorer environments have more difficulty learning from home, where there is not an internet connection, a computer or a desk. All of this leads to profound consequences for society as a whole, and it could also unfold a "generational catastrophe" if we don't pay attention and take action.

Due to this situation we determined one of the best ways we could help and meet those needs was to start the Virtual Learning Center. Thank you to everyone for your prayers and support.
